Board of Education Meeting June 19, 2024

Budget Meeting

• The final 2023-24 Budgets were presented, along with the 2024-25 Budget. The last year had extra costs from extra aides, extra maintenance, and food costs. The extra funds from Covid are gone, so the Board will have to budget more than the past few years. The contract with the union is still not settled. Mental health and the school resource officer are funded. They kept the projected enrollment about the same to budget conservatively. Mr. Keteri said Mr. Nordstrom did a great job and it is nice having that position within the building.

- Negotiations with the teacher union are ongoing. They are far apart now on what each side would like to see.
- He recommends the hiring of Adam Sleeman as 3rd grade teacher, Bridget Weber as the Junior Jets teacher, Nathan Perrault for JHS Business teacher, and Emma Holmes for JHS English teacher. They are still looking for the special education teacher.
- The year is all wrapped up and it was a really good year. They are hopeful that online classes will be used less and more for scheduling purposes. He is optimistic that the Junior Jets program will help the district grow.

Principal's Report-Kim Harris, South Range Elementary

 Mrs. Harris was not present but submitted a written report. It included the Summer Exploration Program which has good registration. It will run for 8 themed weeks. Camp Lahti was a great success, and the staff was pleased with the facility. The GSRP class is maxed out at 16 students.
