Principal's Report-Kim Harris, South Range Elementary

- The Summer Exploration program is running. It has been neat having kids around the building this summer. Ms. Myers, kindergarten teacher, ran a week. Mrs. Irizarry, first grade teacher, has been doing the last few weeks. They are doing a nice job.
- The district received a PREPaRe grant and has a district wide team to work on safety measures. They recently met and will meet again next month.
- Teacher assignments were sent out. Last year's sixth grade was a smaller class. Next year the building will be up by 15 students.
- She will be posting for a parapro. There will be 2 students next year who need a 1:1 aide.
